



INFORMATION TO KEEP HANDY REGARDING YOUR UPCOMING PROCEDURE

This procedure will be done in the Covenant Center for the Heart, located on the second floor on Covenant HealthCare's 900 Cooper building in Saginaw.

Parking for the 900 Cooper building is located directly across the street from the building entrance. A loop driveway for patient/family drop off, providing close access if necessary. Elevators are conveniently located near the building's front entrance.

The hospital will call within a week of your procedure about pre-procedure testing and let you know what time you will need to arrive on the day of your procedure!! If you do not receive a call, contact the pre-procedure testing department at 1-888-213-3939.

1. Do not eat or drink after midnight the morning of your procedure.
2. Do not take any diabetic medication the day of your procedure.
 - If you take Glucophage or Glucovance—hold an additional 2 days after your procedure.
3. Do not take any diuretics (water pills) the day of your procedure (i.e. Lasix, Demadex, Bumex, HCTZ) or blood pressure medication that contains a diuretic.
4. You may take the rest of your medications with a few sips of water the day of your procedure. This includes aspirin and plavix.
6. If you are having a procedure that involves the kidneys, ONLY take 1/2 doses of your blood pressure medication the day of your procedure!!!
7. Bring all medications with you to the hospital.

On the day of your procedure, your physician will go over the results of your procedure with you and your family members – make sure to obtain your results before being discharged from the hospital, as the office will not have that information until a much later date.
